Weathering the storm: De-risking your building for extreme weather events

Geoff Cape is the founder and CEO of Evergreen and has grown the organization to become a nationally recognized leader on urban sustainability with over 160 staff and programs across Canada.

Evergreen has enabled over 7,200 projects over the past 25 years in communities across the country. The largest is Evergreen Brick Works—a unique collection of 16 buildings on a 41-acre campus focused on sustainable cities.

More recent projects include downtown revitalization work in Hamilton, laneway housing planning and policy in Toronto, and a national program called The Future Cities Network that will connect government, industry and academics on the theme of urban innovation in Canada. Mr. Cape is on the Board of Sustainable Development Technologies Canada, a Fellow with the Rockefeller Foundation, a regular participant at the World Economic Forum, Davos, and a past member of the Selection Committee for the WEF Technology Pioneers Awards.

In 2015, Geoff Cape was on Mayor John Tory's "Transition Advisory Team" at the City of Toronto. Mr. Cape has been recognized as one of Canada's Top 40 under 40, winner of the Peter F. Drucker Award, and Canadian Social Entrepreneur of the Year.
